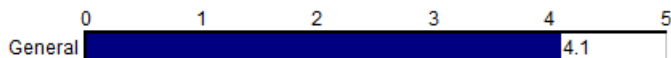

- 7 This outcome was revealed to me by taking the comp classes at SBC. This outcome assisted me by helping me become better at critical thinking at written communication to apply in the rest of the classes I have taken at SBC.
- 8 This outcome was revealed to me at SBC when I was at clinical rotations all fall and spring semester, I had to perform oral and written communication to other nurses and patients. It has assisted me in achieving my educational goals by providing me the training that I need.
